Michael Harris is a freelance writer and an employee at the notorious Little Sister's bookstore. His work appears regularly in Vancouver newspapers."

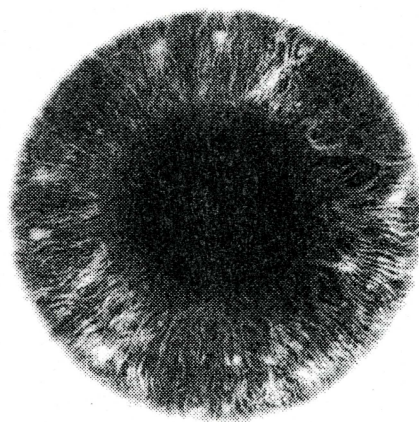
