GENERAL INFORMATION

THIS GUIDE AND MAP HAS BEEN PREPARED FOR THE ASSISTANCE OF THE PUBLIC AND THE FOLLOWING MATTERS SHOULD BE SPECIALLY OBSERVED.

Monday, May 29th

The Citizens are asked to view the procession from a position as near to their own homes as possible. The same procession will tour the residential portion of the route and it is anticipated that a large influx of visitors will crowd the down-town sections.

The street decorations will be left up for several days, so that all persons will have an opportunity of seeing them.

Police regulations will prevent cars from being parked at or in the vicinity of the route of tour, and the principal streets over which the Royal Progress will pass will be closed to traffic throughout the day.

The First and Second Narrows Bridges will be closed to motor traffic between 12 and 5 p.m. on that day. Motor traffic through Stanley Park will be prohibited.

There will be no access permitted to the station or pier properties of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company.

Arrival of trains and boats for that day should be studied as the regular schedules have been considerably altered.

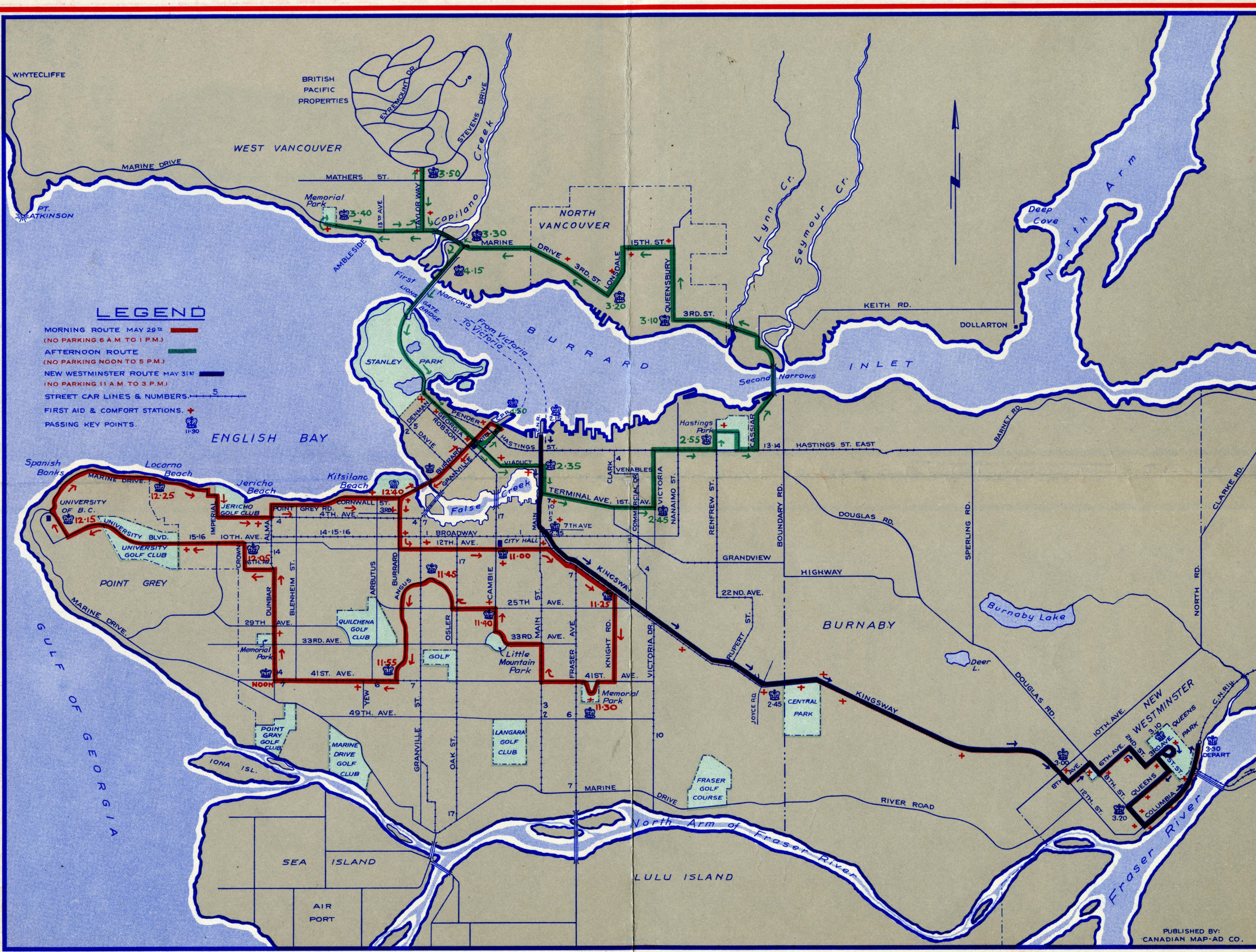
