B & E SAFE BLOWING

DUNCAN, timekeeper, who rpts finding premises B & g on her arrival at 8:00 a.m. by removing glass from rear window. One safe in office had been moved back from its usual position, tipped over on a car cushion, taken from premises, & door of same blown open after dial had been knocked off. This safe contained records only which were not tampered with. A second safe in same office has evidently been prepared for blowing as dial is knocked off, soap cup in place, & what appears to be a quantity of nitro-glycerine is still in cup. Premises examined for possible F.P.'s by Det. F. Smith. Insp. Vance will attd later for purpose of neutralizing explosive in other safe. On arrival of Mr. L. D.
